




Step 1: Attach the legs (2) to the short leg supports (3) and to the long leg supports (4) with 5/16" x 3 ½" bolts (A). Each part has a series of numbers that indicate where to attach the part with the corresponding number.



Step 2: Place the tabletop (1) upside down. After that use 5/16 x $3 \frac{1}{2}$ bolts (A) to attach the legs to the tabletop (1). Each part has a series of numbers that indicate where to attach the part with the corresponding number.



Step 3: Attach the knee braces (5) to the tabletop and to the legs with $5/16^{\prime\prime}$ x $3\frac{1}{2}^{\prime\prime}$ bolts (A). Each part has a series of numbers that indicate where to attach the part with the corresponding number.



Step 4: Finally, turn the table over its feet.
