




Step 1: Place the Tabletop (1) upside down. After that, use 3/8" x 8" bolts (A) and 3/8" x 10" bolts (B) to attach the legs (2) to the tabletop, as shown below. Each part has a series of numbers that indicate where to attach the part with the corresponding number.



Step 2: Attach the long support (3) to the legs with 3/8" x 6" bolts (C). Each part has a series of numbers that indicate where to attach the part with the corresponding number.



Step 3: Attach the short support (4) to the legs with 3/8" x 8" bolts (A). Each part has a series of numbers that indicate where to attach the part with the corresponding number.



Step 4: Finally, turn the table over its feet.
